

God Used Every Story To Complete His Plan

1 Chr 28:4-7 The Lord God of Israel chose me out of all my father's family to be king over Israel forever. For he chose Judah as leader, and from the house of Judah, my father's family, and from my father's sons, he was

pleased to make me king over all Israel. ⁵ And out of all my sons—for the Lord has given me many sons—he has chosen my son Solomon to sit on the throne of the the Lord's kingdom over Israel . . . ⁷ I will establish his kingdom forever And He is using Your Story as well.

²⁸ The sons of Onam were Shammai and Jada. The sons of Shammai were Nadab and Abishur. 29 The sons of Abishur and his wife Abihail were Ahban and Molid. 30 The sons of Nadab were Seled and Appaim. Seled died without children,³¹ but Appaim had a son named Ishi. The son of

Ishi was Sheshan. Sheshan had a descendant named Ahlai. 32 The sons of Jada, Shammai's brother, were Jether and Jonathan. Jether died without children, ³³ but Jonathan had two sons named Peleth and Zaza. These were all descendants of Jerahmeel. 34 Sheshan had no sons, though he did have daughters.

The Generational Theme

Psalm 145:4-7

Let each generation tell its children of your mighty acts; let them proclaim your power. ⁵ I will meditate on your majestic, glorious splendor and your wonderful miracles. ⁶ Your awe-inspiring deeds will be on
